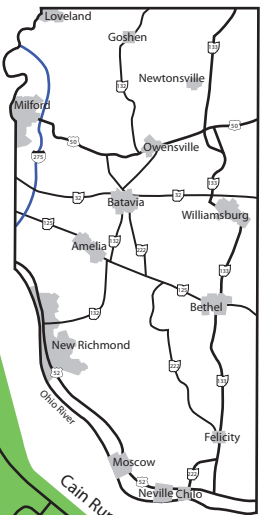


Williamsburg - Batavia Hike Bike Trail Phase One

← Batavia (5 miles)

Phase One of the Williamsburg to Batavia Hike Bike Trail begins at the end of Broadway Street in Williamsburg then connects to Williamsburg-Bantam Road. The trail follows Williamsburg-Bantam then crosses over Cain Run Creek and ends at an overlook area along Harsha Lake. Phase One of the trail is approximately 2.5 miles in length. When completed the total trail length will be 15 miles.

Trailhead parking can be found at the Harmony Hill museum (Third and Lytle), the old high school (Broadway and Main), Third and Main Street, and Community Park

Trail Use
The trail is intended for hikers, joggers, walkers, and bicyclists. No motorized vehicles are permitted on the trail. Horses are only permitted on the portion of the trail that follows Williamsburg-Bantam Road. Horses are not permitted on the Cain Run bridge.
