Minutes of BOARD OF TRUSTEES – BATAVIA TOWNSHIP –

The Board of Trustees of Batavia Township met for a special meeting at 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, October 20, 2021, at the Batavia Township Community Center.

CALL TO ORDER

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Jennifer Haley, Fiscal Officer, gave the roll call for the Board of Trustees. Present were: Mr. Parsons Mr. Perry, and Mr. Sauls. Also present were: Denise Kelley, Zoning Administrator and Jonathan Wocher, Planning Consultant.

PUBLIC HEARING – 6:00 P.M. HERITAGE FARM PD Case #B-03-21ZPD

After the introduction of the Township Board of Trustees and staff, Jonathan Wocher gave a summary of the zone change request for the 39.6 acres.

Rob Smith with D.R. Horton Developers, spoke on behalf of the development. They are proposing 81 lots, 2.12 homes per acre. Lot sizes would be increased to over 10,000 square feet. The buffer was widened to 100 feet with a tree landscape. All roads would be public. The Trustees asked questions and had comments. The meeting was open to comments on behalf of the development.

Bruce Davis, 312 Mt. Holly Rd., spoke on behalf of the development. He has 4.5 acres and will be surrounded by this development. He gave a presentation.

Yvonne Davis, 312 Mt. Holly Rd., spoke on behalf of the development. She stated this is a five-generation farm.

Ed Kluba, 3648 SR 222, spoke on behalf of the development. He would like turn lanes off of Chapel and off of Mt. Holly Rd. There have been 3 wrecks in the past week.

Those who spoke against the development:

Kip Backscheider, 2018 Plumb Lane, spoke on behalf of the Stonegate residents, against the development, concerning the rural character and traffic.

Heather Sewell, 561 Chapel, spoke against the development concerning bad accidents on her property and the traffic issues. Of ten accidents, three occurred in her front yard.

John Mario, 3609 Woodview Lane, a Stonegate resident, spoke against the development concerning bad accidents.

Kasey Drennen, 2046 Plumb Lane, spoke against the development concerning the traffic and density.

Alan Hannan, 2032 Cristata Lane, spoke against the development, density, and gas line running through the berm area. His HOA feels it should be half an acre + per home.

Patrick Stevens, 3474 Winter Holly Dr., spoke against the development concerning traffic, accidents, and home elevations.

Jeffrey Ireton, 561 Chapel commented this is his grandmother's home he lives in. He is concerned about the local school capacities. Mr. Wocher mentioned this is located in the West Clermont School District.

Developer, Rob Smith, offered some rebuttal to the talking points.
