SHERIFF'S DEPARMENT REPORT

Deputy Benkelmann gave the Batavia Township crime stats for July, 2024.

The National Night Out was a success last night.

The Batavia Township Deputies had an increase of 8.7% in offense reports in July. The highest crime type was theft. There were 47 property, 29 violent crimes, 19 personal crimes, 11 drug and alcohol related crimes, 53 informational reports, and 9 juvenile related offenses.

The Clermont County Sheriff Deputies took 141 offense reports, 140 of the incident reports. There were 27 traffic arrests, 77 warnings, 116 warrant services, 393 civil services, 89 assists to other departments, 65 adult arrests, 7 juvenile arrests, and 194 business checks. We took 82% of the incident reports as well as 84% of the offense reports. There was \$10,335.00 in recovered property which included a stolen vehicle. There were 468 neighborhoods patrolled. Most of the traffic arrests occurred in the area of Judd Road. There is a speed sign on Judd. There were zero overdoses for July. There were three burglaries in July. There was one breaking and entering offense.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Jennifer Haley gave an update for Central Joint Fire & EMS District. In June there were 395 EMS runs, 168 fire runs; July had 369 EMS runs, and 175 fire runs. There are many inspections and plan reviews to be completed. There are 5 members on the Committee. There are two Batavia Township Trustees, one member at large. There is also the Village Mayor and a Council member. There were three in attendance at the meeting, the Township Trustees, and the member at large. No one else was at the meeting.

Mr. Parsons gave the update for Batavia Union Cemetery. We operate with the Batavia Village Union Cemetery. This consists of a Trustee, a Village Council member, and a member at large. Batavia Township puts in the same dollar amount in expenses as the Village even though only a small portion is in the Township. So far this year we have had 15 internments, 6 of which have been cremations. We have two work sessions coming up. November 18th and October 30th and 31st. We meet monthly.

SERVICE DIRECTOR REPORT

Cody Smith, Service Director, gave the July report.

We took down a tree at CJFED on Old SR32.

We finished the second catch basin on Lucy Run.

We have been using the new John Deere boom mower almost every day this month, trimming everything back off the roads.

We weedeated around all the signs and guardrails in the Township.

We performed milling and patching on Easter Ave.

We installed a military marker in Olive Branch Cemetery. We set all the military markers.

We installed the new wind screen on the pickleball court.

We performed ditching on Marbe Lane.

The water on Apple Rd caused erosion of the road. The Service Dept. dug it out and put in new blacktop.

There was a sinkhole on Breckenridge Drive which was a water line. The Clermont County Water Dept. will do the repairs.

Cornerstone Development completed the 2-inch water line to the splash pad.

The chain link fence on Lucy Run Cemetery is in bad shape. A tree fell on it as well. The fence will be taken down.

We had one cremation at Lucy Run, one full burial at Olive Branch, and the sale of one grave at Olive Branch.

There was discussion about the paving of Summit Road. It will be paved from old SR32 to the railroad tracks as the prep work is already completed.

PLANNING AND ZONING DIRECTOR/INSPECTOR REPORT

Taylor Corbett, Planning and Zoning Director gave the July report.

We had seven lots sold in Forest Grove, zero in Billingsley, seven lots in Rosewood, one in Derby Place, and five in Heritage Farms. There were zero multifamily homes.

The average total for July was \$388,329. The average for the year is \$389, 439.00. Total year to date single family units is 103 with 11 attached units.

We have zero lots left in Derby Place, 75 available in Rosewood, 47 in Forest Grove, 41 lots in Heritage Farms, 17 in Billingsley-single family section, and then 18 left in Billingsley condos.

Total permits issued year to day totals 318. Taylor presented the list of all permits to the Board.

Taylor reviewed the zoning complaints. There were 54 tagged parking regulation complaints, 45 of which have been resolved.

There are no new Zoning Commission cases and one BZA case at the end of this month.

On the corner of SR125 and Amelia Olive Branch, the site plan for Aldi's has been submitted. There will be a connecting parking lot to the new UDF. Taylor is reviewing the site plan. UDF should be completed by the end of the year.

There was a recess at 5:50 p.m. for ten minutes before the 6:00 p.m. Zoning Hearing.

Karen executed the gas aggregation contract today. The rate is a 30% reduction from our current rate. This will go into effect in October. Residents will get a notification about the aggregation. They can opt out if they choose.
